Math Improvement

Increase basic math skills and challenge higher learning. Goal: Increase DFS from -158 to above -126 by June 2024.

English Language Arts Enhancement

Develop department cohesion, analyze qualitative and quantitative data, implement common rubrics and assessments. Goal: Increase DFS from -25 to above 0 by June 2024.

English Learner Support

Conduct lesson studies, incorporate ELD standards effectively, and differentiate strategies based on students' levels and skills. Goal: Increase reclassification rate from 9% to 15%.

Increasing Academic Rigor

Create rigorous assessments and interdisciplinary studies incorporating LAHSA outcomes and students' knowledge of standards. Goal: Improve all average AP test scores by 0.25 by June 2024.
